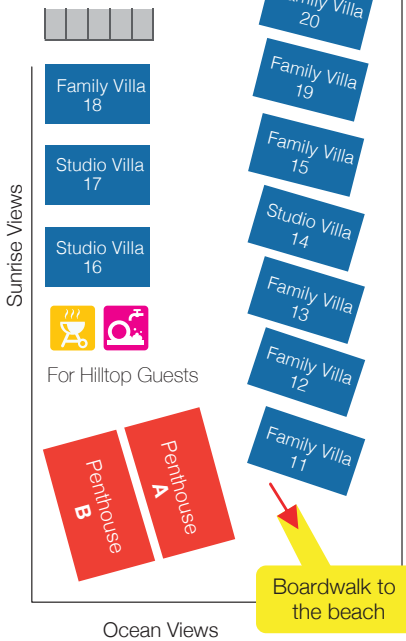

# Park Rules

*Ensuring safety and comfort for all our guests.*

*We hope you enjoy your stay.*

- 1. Reception hours** are 8am - 6pm daily.
  - 2. Check out** is 10am for all accommodation and sites. If you wish to extend your stay for additional night/s please check with Reception before 10am as this is subject to availability. There are no refunds if you choose to leave early.
  - 3. Check in** is 11am for sites and 2pm for all accommodation. Late check-ins up to 8pm by prior arrangement only.
  - 4. Water** is in limited supply, please be 'waterwise'.
    - Drinking water is available outside each amenities block and in the camp kitchen, please use for drinking and cooking only. Peoples Park supplies all of our guests with fresh water showers in ablutions and accommodation. Please fill your tanks before arriving in Coral Bay.
    - Artesian bore water is provided at sites, this is not suitable for drinking or cooking.
  - 5. Sprinklers** run continuously and are moved often to try to keep our lawns green and healthy. Please turn sprinklers off if they are in your way.
  - 6. Speed Limit** in the Park is strictly 5km per hr. This is walking pace and includes bicycles.
  - 7. Guests per site** is a maximum of 2 adults plus 4 children per site. Additional guests or overnight visitors must have prior management approval and must pay an additional fee prior to arrival.
  - 8. Site set up**
    - All Caravans/Camper trailers must have their draw bars facing the roadway.
    - All Caravans/Camper trailers must be 1.5m away from every site boundary (to give 3m separation).
    - Sites must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
    - Open fires are not permitted. Use only approved gas BBQs.
    - If there is no waste water connection between your van and the intake drains, a bucket must be placed to collect your waste water and emptied regularly.
    - No ground tarps, please use shade cloth or approved matting. Please do not put pegs through our shadecloth.
  - 9. Ocean front sites** tents and camper trailers are not allowed in the Ocean Front area.
  - 10. Laundry** washing machines require 4 x \$1 coins per wash. Tumble dryers take 2 x \$2 coins per load. Change is available from reception. All machines run on cold fresh water. Clothes lines are located near both ablution blocks. Please do not hang washing on your site.
  - 11. Dump point** is located near the ocean front ablutions – check the Park Map or ask Reception for directions.
  - 12. Camper's kitchen** has undercover seating, free BBQs, hot plates, microwaves, fridge and dish washing facilities. Lights go off at 10pm.
  - 13. Vehicles** (cars, trailers etc) must not be parked on roadways and there is strictly one vehicle permitted per site. Please ask at Reception if parking for additional vehicles is available. Quad bikes, trail bikes, e-scooters and recreational motor bikes are not to be ridden in the Park.
  - 14. Boat parking** is subject to availability and not guaranteed. Enquire at Reception.
  - 15. Noise** must not affect the quiet enjoyment of other guests. Loud or abusive noise at any time will not be tolerated. No loud music after 7pm and total 'quiet time' is from 10pm.
  - 16. Children** must be supervised at all times by an adult, especially in the ablution blocks and playground. Children must wear helmets whilst riding bikes, scooters and skateboards. E-scooters not permitted.
  - 17. Playground** opening hours are daylight hours only. No one is to use the play equipment outside of this time. Children must be supervised at all times while using the playground.
  - 18. Wildlife** please be aware that kangaroos and reptiles gain entry to the Park from time to time and parents are urged to supervise children. Wildlife should not be approached or provoked in any way. Snake sightings should be reported to Reception as soon as possible - it's best if someone could keep an eye on the snake while it's being reported so that it can be captured and safely relocated.
  - 19. Fish cleaning** or disposal of fish waste is not permitted in the Park. There is a well-equipped fish cleaning station near the public toilets on Robinson Street.
  - 20. Dogs** are not permitted in the Park. Other types of pets will require management approval.
  - 21. Evictions** we reserve the right to evict anyone who creates a problem in the Park, one hours' notice will be given to vacate the Park.
  - 22. Inclement weather** will not justify a refund should a guest wish to leave early or cancel their booking. This includes cyclonic activity at or near Coral Bay. Park Management strongly recommend travel insurance.
  - 23. Extension cords and electrical equipment** brought into the park - Guests warrant that all electrical equipment and extension cords are in good working order. Management accepts no liability for any faulty equipment being used by guests.
  - 24. Gate scan card and ablution key:** \$20 authorisation is taken for gate scan cards on arrival. Toilet keys \$5 each for Ocean Front sites. Missing or lost items will be charged on departure.
  - 25. Zero tolerance policy** abuse towards staff will result in immediate cancellation of current and future bookings.
- These rules are in accordance with the Caravan Park and Camping Grounds Regulations 1997.
